Rev. Sam & June Tonomura Mount Hermon Scholarship Fund.

- a. Established on Nov. 28, 2009 at Sam's retirement celebration by Tonomura children.
- b. Amount: \$31,000. Available for 2010. Each year approx. 2/3 will be the maximum available so 1/3 will be carried forward. Periodic fund raising will be needed. All donors may also contribute to this scholarship fund through JEMS and receive tax deductible receipts..
- c. Purpose: To enable pastors and retire pastors serving or served in JA and Asian American churches and their families to attend and enjoy the blessings of being at JEMS Mount Hermon Summer Conference for one full week..
- d. Conditions and Information:
 - i. 2/3 of the total fund shall be available for Scholarship distribution.
 - ii. Scholarship is primary for pastors and churches which are connected with the ministry of JEMS over the years. **Two scholarships per church are currently available.**
 - iii. The amount of scholarship for each pastor shall be the cost of the "standard rate at the JEMS Mount Hermon Summer Conference. If deluxe unit is selected the difference in rate is expected to be personally covered. His spouse and children attending together at Family Camp will also receive this 50% scholarship or discount. Older children may apply for the separate MH Conferee Scholarship Fund for youth and cabin leaders. Children under age of 12 must attend with their parents to qualify.
 - iv. If necessary, priority will be given to pastor from small or starting churches with membership below 50, who is a first timer or coming from outside California.
 - v. Complete an application form available on JEMS website: www.JEMS.org
 - vi. Scholarship is available on first come first served basis. So early registration is highly recommended in order to obtain housing and be accepted.
