JOB DESCRIPTION

The Youth Director will cultivate a Youth Ministry by fostering an inclusive environment to nurture and equip the youth to spiritual maturity in our Lord Jesus Christ through worship, prayer, Bible study, fellowship, and discipleship relationships. The Youth Director will coordinate and develop strategies for outreach to young people, to work with parents to nurture their children's faith, and to encourage sincere fellowship with appropriate boundaries and discipline.

- Willingness to learn new tasks and systems
- Ability to address confrontation with authenticity, humility and love
